Jul 16 – God reveals to Moses his special mission. Jesus, jumble of heart is our refreshment and rest.

Jul 17 – The paschal meal, the Passover of the Lord, prefigures our sacrifice of thanksgiving done in memory of Jesus, the Lord of the Sabbath.

Jul 18 – The exodus from slavery takes place in hast in a night of vigil for the Lord. The suffering servant seeks faith, not superficial enthusiasm.
