THE LITURGICAL WEEK

Jul 5 – Jesus is met with misgivings and rejection by his own relations. Like them, we often resist the prophetic word because of an obstinacy of heart, rooted in a self-pride which must give way to weakness and powerlessness.

Jul 6 – The Lord promises to remain with Jacob and his descendants. Through various cures, the mission of Jesus is authenticated.

Jul 7 – Having encountered the presence of the divine, Jacob earns the right to enter Canaan. Jesus prays for laborers for the harvest.

Jul 8 – The suns of Jacob seek help from Joseph, their brother. Jesus chooses the Twelve and sends them forth to proclaim God's reign.

Jul 9 – Reconciliation between Joseph and his brothers takes place. Share God's love as gift.

Jul 10 – The migration of Jacob and his descendants to Egypt, a land of security, is described. In preaching the gospel, one may encounter opposition and persecution.
