THE LITURGICAL WEEK

Sep 13 – Isaiah would suffer and call upon the Lord for help. Jesus speaks of his own suffering and death and of the demands of discipleship. What use is faith, to confess that Jesus is the Christ without works of love?

Sep 14 – “Just as Moses lifted up the serpent, so must the Son of Man be lifted up”. “God highly exalted him” and made him Lord! How unforgettable are his deeds!

Sep 15 – Qualities desired in leaders of the faith community are discussed. Pierced with a sword of sorrow, Mary stood by the cross of her Son who “learned obedience from what he suffered”.

Sep 16 – Paul quotes a liturgical hymn which speaks of great deeds: Jesus’ incarnation and resurrection. His advent is met with criticism and indifference.

Sep 17 – Timothy is reminded of his responsibilities as a leader of the faith community. God has sent deliverance to his people: the mystery of his love and forgiveness is revealed in Jesus.

Sep 18 – Paul reminds Timothy of the values which should animate his ministry. Women join the Twelve in following Jesus.

Sep 19 – Serve the Lord and keep his commandments until the Day of Jesus Christ. His word has been planted in our hearts to bear fruit in faith and love.
