**THE LITURGICAL WEEK**

**Oct 11** – When offered the choice between true knowledge or riches, Solomon prays for wisdom of heart. When given the choice between following Jesus or remaining attached to his material wealth, the man chooses his possessions. God's word challenges us to be attached to Jesus and to him alone.

**Oct 12** – Jesus is the sign of God's presence, of God's salvation. He is descended from David and is the Son of God.

**Oct 13** – Creation bespeaks the glory of God. Our actions should bespeak an inner life rooted in the Spirit.

**Oct 14** – Creation is our salvation, patiently awaiting our conversion. Seek justice and goodness, and live the law of love.

**Oct 15** – We are saved by God's gracious mercy, not by our own doing. Such a gift may be rejected, as was Jesus by many of his contemporaries.

**Oct 16** – Blessed are they to whom the Lord imputes no guilt. God watches over us, and so we have nothing to fear.

**Oct 17** – The Lord is faithful to his covenant, to Abraham and his seed. A sign of such love is the Spirit who sustains and supports us.
