Feb 19 – The Lord forgives us in the conversion of our hearts, and rejoices in the reconciliation of one to another.



Forty Days for Life

Forty Days for Life is a peaceful vigil of prayer and fasting to end abortion beginning on February 10 through March 20. It began in 2007. It focuses on 40 days around the clock prayer vigil, held outside an abortion facility or public place in a community. This 40 days of life has been known to have saved 11,165 lives, close 64 abortion centers and 127 abortion workers have quit. This prayer group is made up of 675,000 volunteers in 607 cities in 32 nations.

Abortions are being performed in Sioux City every other Friday. If anyone is interested in praying at this abortion center, you can contact Steve Beller at 402.640.5507 who usually attends these year round. Miracles do happen with prayer and fasting.
