THE LITURGICAL WEEK

Mar 12 – Some people wish to apprehend Jesus. Like a trusting lamb, he takes refuge in God his Father.

Mar 13 – To the exiles in Babylon, Isaiah foretells a new exodus, when the Lord will lead his people from captivity to freedom. True freedom is rooted in the person of Jesus, not in observance of the Law. It is he who challenges us to examine our own hearts before self-righteously judging others.

Mar 14 – Justice, according to the Mosaic Law, prevails for Susanna who trusted in the Lord's goodness. Unlike the perjury of the two elders, Jesus' testimony is true: he is the light of the world.

Mar 15 – The seraph, mounted on the pole, released those doomed to die. Jesus, lifted high on the cross, saves us from death.

Mar 16 – Through God's intervention, the three servants are set free. If we believe in Jesus, his truth will free us from sin and death.

Mar 17 – God makes a covenant with Abraham, who rejoices in Jesus as I AM.

Mar 18 – Denounced for blasphemy, for making himself God's equal, Jesus knows he can trust in God, his strength.
