#### **THE LITURGICAL WEEK**

**Apr 9** – With Jesus there is peace. The apostles give thanks for the action of the Spirit in their midst.

**Apr 10** – Jesus appears to seven of his disciples, among them Peter who proclaims his unfailing love for the Lord. Jesus commissions him to feed the sheep. Later, in the face of persecution, Peter and the apostles proclaim the name of Jesus, the Lamb who was slain and who rescues us from death.

**Apr 11** – With faith in the one sent by the father, Stephen, blameless in life, performed signs for all to see.

**Apr 12** – Stephen entrusts his spirit to the just one, the bread of life come down from heaven.

**Apr 13** – Resolute in their belief in the Risen One, the disciples joyfully proclaim Jesus the Messiah.

**Apr 14** – With joyful praise, Philip proclaims the good news to the Ethiopian: belief in Jesus brings eternal life.

**Apr 15** – Paul is called by Jesus to proclaim the good news to all peoples. Jesus invites all to his Eucharistic banquet.
