THE LITURGICAL WEEK

May 7 – Apollos preaches that Jesus is the Messiah, he who came from the Father, the great King over all the earth.

May 8 – Stephen, the first martyr of the infant Church, washes his robe in the blood of the Lamb, the Alpha and the Omega. He proclaims Jesus Lord and King, Most High over all the earth. In him may all become one.

May 9 – Professing their belief in Jesus, the disciples found in Ephesus are baptized. They rejoice and are glad in the Holy Spirit.

May 10 – Jesus prays for his disciples that their needs might be met. Paul bears witness to the movement of the Spirit in his own life.

May 11 – Paul prays that the elders will keep watch over the church at Ephesus. Jesus prays that his Father will show forth his power and guard and protect his disciples.

May 12 – The Lord encourages Paul in jail, and speaks of his mission to Rome in order that even the center of the Gentile world may come to believe in God’s only Son.

May 13 – Jesus appears to Peter. Paul proclaims him to be risen and alive, and the Lord of all.
