THE LITURGICAL WEEK

June 25— The fall of Jerusalem is lamented. In healing the centurion's servant, Jesus invites all peoples to be members of his kingdom.

June 26—Elisha is summoned to follow the prophet Elijah and to succeed him. Jesus insists that those who follow him must abandon all material or psychological securities, walking ever forward without looking back. It is the Lord alone who is to hold fast our lot. Paul distinguishes between true freedom and license.

June 27— Amos speaks out against idolatry and social injustice. Jesus speaks of the demands of discipleship.

June 28—How often do we fail to hear God's word and sin? How often do we fail to trust in the Lord who loves us?

June 29— Peter, rescued from the power of Herod, and Paul, protected from his enemies, proclaim with their lives that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of the Living God.

June 30— Amos speaks of the judgment of the Lord, thus incurring the opposition of the royal prophets. Jesus, too, is opposed, being accused of blasphemy.

July 1—Amos condemns the hypocrisy of the rich who have strayed from the Lord, preferring empty sacrifice to mercy.
