July 30—Some seek the death of Jeremiah who is protected by God's saving help. Herod has John killed.

July 31—Listen carefully to the voice of the Lord: set your heart on what will last forever. We only fool ourselves if we believe that our possessions will bring us happiness and life. Instead, "grow rich in the sight of the Lord".

Aug 1—Jeremiah exposes the falsehood of Hananiah. Jesus nourishes us with food that will last for ever.

Aug 2—The Lord has rebuilt the tents of Zion, he has restored the tents of Jacob. Jesus is truly the Son of God, whose disciples are accused of breaking the tradition of the elders.

Aug 3—The Lord loves us with an everlasting love, and redeems us. Jesus heals the daughter of a Canaanite woman.

Aug 4—Israel shall be healed and restored as God's holy people. Jesus reveals his messianic power by walking on the water and healing the sick.
