THE LITURGICAL WEEK

Sept 10—Paul speaks of Eucharistic realism and its sacrificial character. A moral life is verified by the fruit it produces.

Sept 11—Moses intercedes on behalf of the people who had turned away from the covenant. The Lord delights not in sin, but in our turning back to him, for a contrite and humbled heart God will never spurn. He sent his Son into the world not to condemn sinners, but to save them.

Sept 12—The Eucharist is to be a sign of the unity which proclaims the death of the Lord. The healing of the centurion’s servant heralds the mission to the Gentiles.

Sept 13—God’s holy people, though possessing differing ecclesial functions and charisms, are rooted in one and the same Spirit. Jesus manifests the inauguration of the messianic era.

Sept 14—“Just as Moses lifted up the serpent, so must the Son of Man be lifted up”. “God highly exalted him” and made him Lord! How unforgettable are his deeds!

Sept 15— Paul proclaims the apostolic kerygma of the tradition: the death and resurrection of Christ. Let us give thanks for the Lord is good. Pierced with a sword of sorrow, Mary stood by the cross of her Son who “learned obedience from what he suffered.”

Sept 16 – If Christ has been raised, we shall share his glory. Among Jesus’ first disciples are women who announce the kerygma.

Sept 17—Paul proclaims the doctrine of the final resurrection: that which is won rises incorruptible. Seed sown on good ground yields a harvest of eternal life.
