### **THE LITURGICAL WEEK**

**Sept 3**—The Lord is near to those who suffer. Thus is his wisdom revealed. Jesus reveals himself as “Lord even of the sabbath.”

**Sept 4**—Who can comprehend the Lord’s ways or conceive what the Lord intends? True wisdom leads us to acknowledge our limitations (a matter of “calculation”) and our idols of materialism as we seek to follow the Lord without reservation. True discipleship calls us to forgive those who have wronged us. May we gain wisdom of heart to discern more fully our call to take up the cross of Jesus.
