THE LITURGICAL WEEK

Oct 30—The Lord is full of mercy and compassion, slow to anger and of great kindness. He has come to search out and save what was lost. Let us be more concerned with doing the Lord's work than with idle speculation about when he will come again.

Oct 31—There is no room for pride within the Eucharistic assembly. Open to all, it should signify communion of mind and heart.

Nov 1—Let us rejoice in all the men and women, blest in the eyes of the Lord, who celebrate the heavenly liturgy. They stand in God's holy place and sing of the love the Father has bestowed upon them through the blood of the Lamb.

Nov 2—As suggested: The souls of the just are in God's hands. Christ, the Good Shepherd, died for us while we were still sinners. He is the resurrection and the life.

Nov 3—True circumcision is not a matter of physical operation, but of faith in Christ Jesus. He seeks out the lost and delights in repentance. May his name be praised!
