THE LITURGICAL WEEK

Nov 13—Jesus teaches that his disciples will be persecuted as a necessary prelude to the parousia. Through their perseverance, they will emerge victorious when the Lord comes again. As we await the Day, let us conscientiously fulfill our Christian obligations.

Nov 14—The end time is near. Return to the Lord, be healed of your blindness, and follow not sinful ways.

Nov 15—Beware of inner blindness and indifference to the Gospel. Repent and you shall be victorious.

Nov 16—The heavenly liturgy resounds with hymns of praise. As stewards of the kingdom, we must give an account of God's gifts.

Nov 17—The destruction of Jerusalem is foretold. As the Lamb of the heavenly Jerusalem, his praises are sung by God's people.

Nov 18—John is called to proclaim the revelation of Jesus, a message sweeter than honey to the tongue. Jesus cleanses the Temple.

Nov 19—Though persecuted, we shall be delivered by faith in the paschal mystery: victory over death in bodily resurrection.
