THE LITURGICAL WEEK

Mar 26—Samuel does not see as God sees in the choice of David, who is anointed with oil. As Jesus cures the blind man, so too are we brought from darkness into light through the grace of baptism.

Mar 27—The prophecy of eschatological hope finds its fulfillment in Jesus who heals and restores to life, who rescues us from death.

Mar 28—From the temple of Sion flows a stream of life-giving water, a symbol of the healing grace of baptism.

Mar 29—As the prophet proclaims God's faithful love for his people, so Jesus speaks of his union with his Father.

Mar 30—Moses, who interceded on behalf of the Israelites, will accuse all unbelievers before the Father.

Mar 31—Jesus' enemies begin to plot against him. He professes to have knowledge of God, and trust in his love.

Apr 1—Some people wish to apprehend Jesus. Like a trusting lamb, he takes refuge in God his Father.
