THE LITURGICAL WEEK

May 7—God has made Jesus both Lord and Messiah. Through his wounds we have been healed and have returned to our shepherd. Let us listen to his voice and follow him.

May 8—Jesus is the good shepherd. Through him even the Gentiles have won life-giving repentance and have been invited to give thanks at his altar.

May 9—The good news that Jesus is the Messiah is proclaimed beyond Judaism, to the Greeks in Antioch.

May 10—Paul and Barnabas are endorsed by the Church in Antioch to go to all people and preach that Jesus is the Light who has come into the world.

May 11—Sent forth as a messenger, Paul proclaims the Lord’s favor in his discourse in Antioch in Pisidia.

May 12—God fulfills the psalm by raising Jesus from the dead. He is the way, the truth, and the life.

May 13— Paul and Barnabas turn toward the Gentiles, and thus perform a “greater” work: proclaiming Jesus as Lord.
