# THE LITURGICAL WEEK

**June 4**–All of us have been baptized into one and the same Spirit. That same Spirit, the Advocate, our comfort and refreshment, was given as a gift to the disciples to strengthen them to go forth in the name of the Lord, "to renew the face of the earth"

**June 5–**The father of Tobiah, being an upright man, buried one of his slain kinsfolk. Jesus tells a parable which speaks of his own future suffering and death.

**June 6**–Though experiencing physical and domestic difficulties, Tobit trusts in the Lord. Jesus speaks of religious and civic duties.

**June 7**–Tobit and Sarah, both deeply grieved in spirit, lift up prayers to the Lord. Jesus speaks of his life after death.

**June 8**—Raphael leads Tobiah to Sarah and they are joined in marriage. Love of God and neighbor is the heart of the Christian message.

**June 9–**Tobit is healed of his blindness through the intercession of Raphael. The Messiah is at once Son of David and Lord, both human and divine.

**June 10–** Raphael reveals his identity to Tobit and his son. Tobit praises God for his love and mercy. Jesus praises the widow who gave, not from her excess, but from what little she possessed.
