## THE LITURGICAL WEEK

Nov 19 – Those who use their gifts and talents in the service of one another, especially the poor and the needy, are blessed indeed. They shall be known as children of the light, and will be ready for the Lord's return.

Nov 20-Antiochus IV Epiphanes seeks to introduce Hellenism into Palestine and abolish Jewish law. Many resolve to resist such oppression. Jesus heals a blind man.

**Nov 21–**Trusting in the Lord, Eleazar is killed, becoming a model of courage and virtue. Meeting Jesus, Zacchaeus repents of his sins.

**Nov 22**—Steadfast in the paths of the Lord, a mother and her sons remain faithful to the Law. By using wisely our many blessings, growth in the kingdom takes place.

**Nov 23**—A revolt against the Hellenists is led by Mattathias, the upright one . Jesus weeps over Jerusalem for failing to choose peace.

**Nov 24**—With songs of praise, the Temple is purified and rededicated in December, 164 BC (recalled annually in the Jewish feast of Hanukkah, "the feast of lights"). The Temple is to be a house of prayer.

**Nov 25-** Antiochus, whose army is turned back, expresses sorrow for the trials he wrought upon Jerusalem. Jesus affirms the reality of bodily resurrection.
