THE LITURGICAL WEEK

May 13—As a witness of Jesus' resurrection, Matthias is chosen to replace him "who was destined to be lost". Let us bless the Lord who has so loved us and in whom we are called to love one another.

May 14—Matthias is chosen by lot and added to the Eleven. Thus elected by God, he goes forth and bears fruit.

May 15—Jesus prays for his disciples that their needs might be met. Paul bears witness to the movement of the Spirit in his own life.

May 16—Paul prays that the elders will keep watch over the church at Ephesus. Jesus prays that his Father will show forth his power and guard and protect his disciples.

May 17—The Lord encourages Paul in jail, and speaks of his mission to Rome in order that even the center of the Gentile world may come to believe in God's only Son.

May 18—Jesus appears to Peter. Paul proclaims him to be risen and alive and the Lord of all.

May 19—Paul, Peter, and John, apostles and witnesses of the risen Lord, faithfully proclaim the kingdom of God.
