**July 19**—The Lord hears the prayer of the poor as they struggle for peace and justice. In the Lord is our rest and refreshment.

**July 20**—God hears Hezekiah and saves him from death. Human needs take precedence over ritual laws.

**July 21**—Social injustice is denounced by Micah. The suffering servant seeks faith, not superficial enthusiasm.
