THE LITURGICAL WEEK

Aug 26—Joshua confronts the tribes of Israel: Will you desert your covenant with Yahweh? The desertion of disciples is a prelude to the paschal mystery. With Peter, however, let us profess our faith in the Lord, who gave himself up for us all.

Aug 27—Paul proclaims the Lord's praises, giving thanks for his grace in Thessalonika. Beware of hypocrisy.

Aug 28—Though the Lord's coming is certain, it will be delayed. Jesus criticizes those scribes and Pharisees who place observance of tradition over the demands of love.

Aug 29—Paul sets an example of how believers are to work for the good of the community. John won for himself the crown of martyrdom by being beheaded.

Aug 30—Paul praises the Lord for graces bestowed upon the Corinthians. Let us remain blameless till the day of the Lord.

Aug 31—The Lord's plan entails the cross, a stumbling block and an absurdity for many. Be alert for the Lord's coming.

Sept 1—The Lord has chosen the weak to shame the strong. We are called to exercise stewardship over our gifts.
