THE LITURGICAL WEEK

Sept 9—The advent of the age of salvation is upon us: the deaf hear, the blind see, and those bowed down are raised up. The kingdom is made manifest around the Eucharistic table, where rich and poor alike are invited to feast.

Sept 10—Put aside the old leaven of wickedness and corruption. Instead, put on love, assisting those who are alone and in need.

Sept 11—The Lord delights in his people who are to display charity when judging others. The Twelve are chosen by Jesus.

Sept 12—Above all, be ready for Christ's coming, for he is the Lord. Blest are those who will inherit the kingdom.

Sept 13—Christians are to be guided by the Lord, respecting the consciences of believers who are scrupulous or weak. Love must go beyond natural communities and reach out to all.

Sept 14—"Just as Moses lifted up the serpent, so must the Son of Man be lifted up". "God highly exalted him" and made him Lord! How unforgettable are his deeds!

Sept 15-Paul speaks of Eucharistic realism and its sacrificial character. Pierced with a sword of sorrow, Mary stood by the cross of her Son who "learned the obedience from what he suffered".
