## THE LITURGICAL WEEK

**Sept 16**—Discipleship entails denying our very selves and following the way of the Lord, a way of suffering and service. In professing our faith in him we can rely on the Lord for strength and salvation.

**Sept 17**—The Eucharist is to be a sign of the unity which proclaims the death of the Lord. The healing of the centurion's servant heralds the mission to the Gentiles.

**Sept 18**–God's holy people, though possessing differing ecclesial functions and charisms, are rooted in one and the same Spirit. Jesus manifests the inauguration of the messianic era.

**Sept 19**—The greatest of all gifts is love which seeks justice and right. The preaching of the Baptizer and of Jesus is met with criticism and indifference.

**Sept 20**—Paul proclaims the apostolic kerygma of the tradition: the death and resurrection of Christ. It is he who forgives us our sins. Let us give thanks for the Lord is good.

**Sept 21**–Matthew (or Levi), the tax collector, is called to be an evangelist to proclaim the good news by word and deed. **Sept 22-**Paul proclaims the doctrine of the final resurrection: that which is sown rises incorruptible. Seed sown on good ground yields a harvest of eternal life.
