Feb 9—Jesus, the shepherd, has pity for the crowd. In his blood the new and eternal covenant has been ratified for his sheep.

Feb 10—Isaiah, a man of unclean lips, beholds the Lord's glory in the temple and is sent on mission. Simon, a sinner, responds to the mission of Jesus by becoming a disciple. Paul, the persecutor, speaks of his call to preach nothing but Christ crucified and risen.

Feb 11– All creation is proclaimed good in the sight of God. All nations are invited to share in messianic blessings.

Feb 12- made in God's image, we, nevertheless, often judge by human standards rather than by divine commandments.

**Feb 13**—An ancient creation narrative is presented. Jesus speaks of evil in the heart.
