#### THE LITURGICAL WEEK

**Mar 30**— It is love that the Lord desires, not sacrifice; he longs for sincerity and humility of heart.

Mar 31—Having arrived in the promised land, the Hebrew celebrated their deliverance from affliction and distress in the Passover. Christ, our Passover, has entrusted to us the message of reconciliation: let us forgive one another and celebrate the unconditional and abundant love of God our Father.

**Apr 1–** The prophecy of eschatological hope finds it fulfillment in Jesus who heals and restores to life, who rescues us from death.

**Apr 2**– From the temple of Sion flows a stream of lifegiving water, a symbol of the healing grace of baptism.

**Apr 3**—As the prophet proclaims God's faithful love for his people, so Jesus speaks of his union with his Father.

**Apr 4**—Moses, who interceded on behalf of the Israelites, will accuse all unbelievers before the Father.

**Apr 5**—Jesus' enemies begin to plot against him. He professes to have knowledge of God, and trusts in his love.
