THE LITURGICAL WEEK

Apr 20— Alleluia! The stone rejected by the builders has become the cornerstone! If we have died with Christ, we shall also rise with him and pass from death to life.

Apr 21—On this day of days we offer a joyful sacrifice of praise to the Father who raised his Son from the dead. Let us be intent upon the life Christ offers us, Christ our Passover who has been sacrificed.

Apr 26—His personal experience of the Risen One leads Peter to proclaim salvation in the name of Jesus of Nazareth, the "stone rejected by the builders."
