#### THE LITURGICAL WEEK

**June 1**— Apollo preaches that Jesus is the Messiah, he who came from the Father, the great King over all the earth.

**June 2**—Stephen, the first martyr of the infant Church, washes his robe in the blood of the Lamb, the Alpha and Omega. He proclaims Jesus Lord and King, Most High over all the earth. In him may all become one.

**June 3–** Professing their belief in Jesus, the disciples found in Ephesus are baptized. They rejoice and are glad in the Holy Spirit.

**June 4**– Jesus prays for his disciples that their needs might be met. Paul bears witness to the movement of the Spirit in his own life.

**June 6**—The Lord encourages Paul in jail, and speaks of his mission to Rome in order that even the center of the Gentile world may come to believe in God's only Son.

**June 7**—Jesus appears to Peter. Paul proclaims him to be risen and alive, and the Lord of all.
