THE LITURGICAL WEEK

June 29—Peter, rescued for the power of Herod, and Paul, protected from his enemies, proclaim with their lives that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of the living God.

June 30—Elisha is summoned to follow the prophet Elijah and to succeed him. Jesus insists that those who follow him must abandon all material or psychological securities, walking ever forward without looking back. It is the Lord alone who is to hold fast our lot. Paul distinguishes between true freedom and license.

July 1— Jesus calls us to follow him who is rich in kindness and slow to anger.

July 2— The Lord rains fire and brimstone on sinful Sodom and Gomorrah. Jesus seeks greater faith in his frightened disciples.

July 3—Our faith is built upon the apostles who saw the risen Lord and proclaimed his resurrection.

July 4—Abraham’s deep faith and trust is mirrored in the paralytic whose sins are forgiven by Jesus.

July 5—In his goodness, god promises Abraham that his descendants will be blessed in the marriage of Isaac and Rebekah. Divine mercy, not human justice, is at the heart of true religion.
