Friends,

As anyone that has had the privilege of working with the less fortunate can tell you, one of the first things you notice is what some call, "the aroma of Christ". After all, many of those living in poverty or on the street do not possess the same opportunity or even desire for personal hygiene that we take for granted. As a result, the accumulation of days, weeks and months of dirt and grime that has built up gives them a distinctive, and, quite frankly, offensive presence. What I find amazing, however, is that none of them recognize this. In fact, they have become so accustomed to living in squalor that it has desensitized them to its repugnance.

Perhaps surprisingly, however, the same thing happens to each of us as well. For even though our bodily hygiene may be more refined, the same type of thing can happen to our souls. For when you think about it, sin is to our soul what dirt is to our body. Just like dirt accumulates on our bodies, making it offensive to all, so, too, sin accumulates on our soul, making it offensive to all. To make it even worse, we can become so used to our sinfulness that we fail to recognize our offensiveness. In fact, how often do we find ourselves questioning why someone reacts to us in a negative way? How often do we ask, 'what's wrong with them?" Well, maybe nothing is wrong with them. Maybe we are the offensive ones, and they are simply reacting to our repugnance.

Perhaps, the most frequent way this reality is manifested is with our insensitivity. In fact, one of the things that scares me most about my particular judgement is recognizing all the ways I could have really helped someone but failed to recognize the opportunity. This is one of the most damning effects of our sin. For instead of noticing the needs and desires of others, we are almost totally absorbed by the needs and desires of our own.

It seems to me that this is most perfectly seen with our attitude toward the most Holy Eucharist. After all, simply think for a moment about what the Church teaches about the bread and wine that are brought forward during the offertory at Mass. We believe that this bread and wine is truly and substantially changed, not merely to something really special, but into the very Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ that walked on this earth some two thousand years ago.

What could we possibly call our reaction to this truth but insensitive? After all, imagine if it was Tom Brady or Taylor Swift or even President Donald Trump that arrived at Mass when the bells ring during the consecrations. Undoubtedly, everyone's attention, mine, too, would be instantly captivated by their celebrity. Yet none of these, nor any other human being holds a candle to the 'celebrity' of the Divine Son of God, our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Yet, how attentive are we at His coming? Is that not the very definition of insensitive?

After all, if Tom Brady was willing to meet personally with any Patriot fan at any time in our own area, or if Taylor Swift was willing to give a personal concert for any music fan at any time in our own area, or if President Donald Trump were...well, let's set that aside...would anything keep us from that appointment. Well, there's something infinitely greater with us in the Church than any of these jokers. For our God loves us so much that He is willing to humiliate Himself to become present and available to us in this way. Have we become too insensitive to respond?
