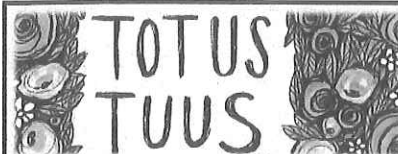

TREASURES OF THE CHURCH: RELIC OF THE TRUE CROSS, MARY'S VEIL, AND MORE: A healing ministry, teaching and exposition of more than 150 sacred relics—some believed to be as old as 2,000 years. Among the treasures are relics of St. Therese of Lisieux, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas and St. Faustina. In addition, there will be a piece of the veil believed to have belonged to Our Lady and one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. Presented by Fr.
