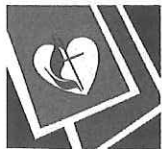

***A NOTE FROM FR. OLSEN - 2019 HOLIDAY MASS SCHEDULES:**

After discussing the Mass schedule with various representatives from each parish, we will be trying out this Mass schedule for Thanksgiving and Christmas this year:

- *Mass on Thanksgiving will be at 8:00 AM in both Lindsay and Humphrey and 9:30 AM in both Tarnov and Leigh.
- *Christmas, Mass would follow the normal weekend Mass schedule, except for Midnight Mass in Humphrey.
 - Christmas Eve Masses would be at 5:00 PM in Lindsay and 5:30 PM in Humphrey.
 - Midnight Mass would be in Humphrey.
 - Masses on Christmas morning would be 8:00 AM in Lindsay, 8:30 AM in Leigh, 10:00 AM in Humphrey and 10:30 AM in Tarnov.
