Important Announcement

This past week, I approached the finance committee about moving the Sunday mass time from the current time of 8:30 to 8:00am. There are several reasons for this adjustment.

- It is extremely rushed trying to get to Humphrey for the 10:00am mass. I've never made it prior to 9:45 and there's always a rush to make sure everything is ready, find ministers and set up, among other things. Because of this, it is extremely difficult for Fr. Wayne and me to get recollected in the way that is fitting for mass.
- Second, winter weather will certainly make this process even more frantic if the schedule remains unchanged.
- Third, during certain times of the year like Christmas and Easter mass will necessarily run longer because of the increased festivity of the season, making the process even more hectic.
- Fourth, one of the really cool things about Holy Family is the tradition of everyone visiting after mass. It is impossible for the priests to enjoy this time of fellowship because we have to rush off to Humphrey. Moving the mass time up a half hour would allow us the opportunity to participate and give me personally a chance to get to know people better.

The finance committee enthusiastically agreed with this reasoning. Therefore, on the first week of Advent, December 1st, Sunday morning mass in Lindsay will move to 8:00am. I regret any inconvenience this will cause, but it is a necessary adjustment resulting from the new cluster model. Please continue to pray for vocations!

Looking ahead...I've been giving some thought to the Mass Schedule for Thanksgiving and Christmas. I'm leaning toward having mass on Thanksgiving at 8am in both Lindsay and Humphrey and 9:30 in both Tarnov and Leigh. For Christmas, Mass would follow the normal weekend mass schedule, except for midnight mass in Humphrey. Christmas Eve masses would be at 5 and 5:30 in Lindsay and Humphrey respectively. Midnight mass would be in Humphrey. Masses on Christmas morning would be 8:00am in Lindsay, 8:30am in Leigh, 10:00am in Humphrey and 10:30am in Tarnov.
