Friends,

One of my favorite childhood memories is attending Nebraska football games with my dad. We were blessed to have two season tickets, but since there were others, including brothers and sisters who also wanted to attend, I usually only went to one game a year.

I never got to pick which one. If I had, I would always choose Nebraska vs Oklahoma in the years Oklahoma came to Lincoln. On the one hand this makes sense. Back in the 70s and 80s, Nebraska versus Oklahoma always decided the Big 8 Championship and usually effected the National Championship as well. On the other hand, these two teams always played in late November, which means the weather was horrible. Additionally, this was one of the rare games that was always on TV. Wouldn't it make sense to watch from the comfort of their own couch rather than sitting in the cold, wind, rain and even snow hundreds of feet away from where the action is taking place?

The answer is unequivocally, NO. Every true fan knows it's better to attend the game than watch on television. Sure, it may be more comfortable at home. You may be able to see better at home. It may be more affordable to watch from home. But, there's nothing like being in the stadium if you want the fullest, most complete experience.

It works the same way with the Mass. I am so grateful to the technology people at Holy Family and St. Francis for making livestreaming of the Mass possible. Of course, there are going to be some technical glitches and some things to iron out. But, at a time when we are prevented from attending Mass in person, it is a wonderful gift to be able to watch it at home from your church with your

But, like the football game, it's not the same. In fact, one of the dangers in this experience is that we view the Mass as just another program we are viewing at home through our screens. It is incredibly difficult to worship with the Mass rather than watch it. Our surroundings, including the medium we are viewing, are all tempting us to sit back and watch precisely because that's what we've always done in these settings. However, we are striving NOT to watch the Mass per se. We striving to participate; trying to pray the Mass at home just like we would at Church.

Some practical suggestions might help us do that. First, where we watch Mass as a family can make a difference. If we watch Mass in the same environment as we watch the game, it is going to be harder to differentiate the two experiences. Rather, try to watch Mass in a different location. Maybe that means moving the screen we are watching it on, moving the furniture, or using a room that is different than the one we usually watch things. Any way we can differentiate watching a ballgame from worshipping the Mass helps us use this opportunity more effectively.

A second practical suggestion is to participate as best you can. For instance, one thing you discover when you are praying the Mass in a smaller group is how the momentum of the crowd assists us in "remembering" our prayers. The same prayers that flow so easily in the church when you're surrounded by a congregation do not come as easily when you are at home with your family. Nevertheless, it is important to make the effort to respond as best we can so that we are not watching the Mass. Rather, we are praying it.

This includes posture. Obviously, there can be certain limitations on imitating the postures we use at Mass when we are participating at home. Nevertheless, it is important that we stand, sit and kneel as we would in Church. Not only does our posture serve as a prayer, it also helps the mind concentrate by putting it in the disposition of prayer in the actions of the body.

Hopefully, this will all be behind us shortly. Nevertheless, it is important for us to take advantage of the opportunities these challenges provide. The Lord has a special love for people
