Holy Family Prayer Chain Update

A **prayer chain** is a list of people who agree to **pray** for others during a difficult time. It is used in many ways: to seek comfort, ask for guidance, heal and restore, celebrate joy, and/or update parish members on important events. You may ask for prayers anonymously. There are 2 options available.

Calling Prayer Chain: The person in need calls Cindy Klassen or Rose Wiese to start the Calling Prayer Chain. Each person on the list notifies the name below them. If someone is not home, they leave a message and call the next person.

Text Prayer Chain: Call Rose Wiese and a text is sent out to everyone on the list asking for prayer. Please do NOT respond to the text when you receive it, simply pray for the need and ask God for healing and/or comfort.
