Friends,

I must confess, I'm somewhat sympathetic to the phrase "Black Lives Matter", and, quite frankly, wish everyone would at least take it seriously. While it is equally true that "All Lives Matter", not all lives are under assault in our country like black lives are.

Of course, the phrase "Black Lives Matter" is one thing. Those that use this phrase as a rallying cry to violence, especially violence against law enforcement, is an entirely different story and one that is patently unchristian. To see this, simply look to the life of Jesus Christ. Recall that Jesus Christ is executed at the hands of a law enforcement system that is notoriously corrupt. Yet, Jesus' followers don't use this injustice as a rallying cry for violence and retribution. Neither do they seek revenge. Jesus Himself doesn't even fight back against this injustice as it is happening. Rather, Jesus offers forgiveness, and it is through Jesus' act of forgiveness that the world is transformed.

Nevertheless, just because certain ideologies are corrupting the phrase "Black Lives Matter" and using it as a rationalization for violence, doesn't mean that the reality it identifies should be ignored. It is undeniable that blacks today are being both targeted and killed at a rate far higher than whites. This is not done by the police, but it is systematic. The targeting and killing of innocent blacks is not at the hands of police like it is in the hands of abortionists.

The statistics are striking:

- According to the CDC, 36% of abortions are of black babies even though blacks are 13.6% of the population.
- More black babies have been aborted since 1973 (approx. 20 million) than the black population in 1960.
- In 2016, in New York City, more black babies were aborted (49%) than were carried to term (47%).
- According to the Guttmacher policy review, black women are more than 5 times as likely as white women to have an abortion.

This is no accident. There has been a war on blacks in our country even after the Civil War ended slavery. In fact, since at least the 1930s, there have been coordinated and deliberate efforts in the United States to "exterminate" black lives. Here's an example of one plan:

"We should hire three or four colored ministers, preferably with social-service backgrounds, and with engaging personalities. The most successful educational approach to the Negro is through a religious appeal. We don't want the word to go out that we want to exterminate the Negro population, and the minister is the man who can straighten out that idea if it ever occurs to any of their more rebellious members." ~Margaret Sanger, Founder of Planned Parenthood, December 19, 1939, letter to Dr. Clarence Gamble

Now, please don't misunderstand, I don't for one instant believe the vast majority of people that work for or support Planned Parenthood share such diabolical intention. But, whether it is intended by them, whether it is intended by their founder or her successors, or whether they are simply all duped by the devil, the effects are undeniable. It can't be simply coincidence that an estimated 78% of all Planned Parenthood locations are in minority neighborhoods. In fact, according to Life Site news:

"[an] analysis of 2010 Census Bureau data shows that Planned Parenthood continues to strategically place the majority of their surgical abortion facilities in locations that target Black Americans for abortion. This analysis shows that 62% of Planned Parenthood abortion facilities are within walking distance (2 miles) of relatively high African American populations."

If I were a member of the black community undergoing this assault, I'd be furious. Heck, even though I'm not, I still find it infuriating. It sure makes sense to me why some would want to emphasize that "Black Lives Matter". They are clearly being targeted and attacked via abortion disproportionately.



(CONTINUED FROM PAGE 1) But, it also makes me wonder why people using that phrase as a justification for violence direct their fury at the police rather than abortion providers like Planned Parenthood. For not only does abortion terminate literally millions more black lives than the police do, it is also done systematically and purposely.

The sad reality is that abortion is the fount from which the violence in our society flows. Like it or not, we are all infected by it. Our dedicated law enforcement officials are infected by it, and sometimes go too far. They are not alone. Our doctors, our teachers, our farmers and our priests, including the author of this article, are all infected by it and may sometimes go too far. By definition, you cannot live in a culture, any culture, and not be affected by it. As Pope St. John Paul II rightly recognized, we live in a culture of death.

But, in addition to being perpetrators of violence, even if only subtly, we are all also victims of it and none more so than the black Americans. If we want the violence to stop, we must shut off its source, which is abortion. How?

Well, as always, Jesus Christ provides the answer. That answer isn't violence. It isn't revenge. It isn't even justice. It is forgiveness. The only antidote to the culture of death is mercy. The only way for violence to end is for forgiveness to heal it.

However, forgiveness doesn't mean that no action should be taken. On the contrary, all of us, regardless of race, have the obligation to stand up to the fount of violence in our society that is abortion. This is not done by the tactics of violence, vengeance and retribution adopted by so many that claim "Black Lives Matter" as their inspiration. Rather it is done by following the example of Martin Luther King, Jr. and imitated by the pro-life movement for over four decades. Only peaceful protests emphasizing mercy and forgiveness will transform hearts corrupted by the culture of death. It may take time. It will certainly take prayer and, perhaps especially, fasting. But, when that day comes when all lives, especially the black lives that are disproportionately under attack in our society today, really do matter, all that effort will be worth it.
