Friends,

I don't know what it is, but Dr. Pepper tastes even better to me in a glass with no ice than it does straight out of a can. As a result, whenever I'm sitting down eating pizza and drinking Dr. Pepper, which is most of the time, I pour my Dr. Pepper into a glass. Sometimes, though, I run into a problem. Since I enjoy doing dishes about as much as a visit to the proctologist, I don't always have glasses that pass even my abysmal standards of cleanliness. So instead of doing dishes, maybe I could grab my chalice from the sacristy and pour my Dr. Pepper in it.

Of course, this is repulsive, but understanding why it is repulsive is interesting. Clearly, the reason using a chalice to drink Dr. Pepper makes our stomach churn is because the chalice is sacred. When I take a chalice out of its sacred role and use it in an ordinary way it becomes, not only revolting, but a sacrilege, which gives the action a special repugnance.

Yet many people do a very analogous thing in another sacred reality. In fact, when I ask people what the Church thinks about sex, I usually get one of two responses. Some respond that the Church says it's bad while the majority respond that the Church says it's good. Although the latter is more correct than the former, there is still something lacking even when we confess that sex is good. After all, sex is not good like Dr. Pepper is good. No, rather sex is good like my chalice is good. It is a sacred good set apart for a sacred use by God Himself.

To better understand this, first recognize that sex shares an important commonality with the other sacraments. Every sacrament has an outward sign that points to a hidden reality. For instance, in the sacrament of baptism, water is poured on the baby's head, not because the head is dirty, but rather because it is a sign of the spiritual washing of the child's soul. The same kind of thing happens in the Eucharist. We consume the sacred species by eating, not to nourish our body, but to feed our soul. The consuming of the sacred species is a sign of this hidden reality.

The same concept happens with sex. Sex is a physical sign of a hidden reality. The physical sign is the unification of two bodies. The hidden reality is the unification of two persons, body and soul, now become one flesh.

Seen in this light, we see one of the most beautiful realities of the sexual act. For each time a married couple engages in the marital act they are renewing their marriage vows. When the couple first pronounced these vows, they used words publicly stated in front of God, His minister and everyone else who is important in their lives, that these two individuals had given themselves to each other and become one flesh. In the sexual act, spouses do the very same thing, not with words, but with actions. For the unification of the sexual act is the sign that two people have become one flesh. Each and every time that one-flesh union is enjoyed, the marital vows are renewed, if not in words, by actions, which speak much more loudly.

This beauty of sex is also why the same pit in the stomach we feel at the suggestion of using a chalice to drink Dr. Pepper is present whenever sex is taken out of its sacred context. For sex, outside of marriage, is not really sex at all. It is best described with another word that starts with "f" rhymes with "ducking". In fact, this is the most apt description of sex outside of marriage. Uniting physically with one you haven't united with spiritually is telling a lie with your bodies. With your bodies, you may testify that the two have become one flesh, but the words have not. Since our bodies are sacred, these sins feel more shameful, which is why so many attempt to protect themselves from this shame by rationalizing that such behavior is tolerable. It is not, nor can it ever be; not because God wants to kill our fun, but rather because God wants us to enjoy sex, not by using the other person, but rather by giving ourselves to the other person.


