Friends,

I'll never forget the day my very first dog got hit by a car. Being my first dog, it was particularly special to me. We got it when it was only days old. I got to name it. And, if I do say so myself, it was probably the smartest, best dog that has ever existed.

I knew something was wrong the second I got off the bus and my dad met me at the bottom of our lane. Being all of nine years old, I had outgrown being walked to the house by my parents many moons ago. Not only that, but it was clear that my dad was uneasy. I was struck by this because, as a true Dane, my dad seldom revealed any emotion. But now he seemed nervous. As we walked up our driveway, I soon found out why. My dad explained that Red had been hit by a car and that there was no way he would ever get better. Worst of all, my dad said, "so I had to shoot him." I was crushed. Only years later did I understand. It was pointless to allow an animal to suffer.

Curiously, this same kind of mindset is beginning to catch on with humans. Many in our Culture of Death think that Euthanasia, so-called "mercy killing", is just as applicable to humans as it is to animals. The truth is, and I'm amazed I even have to say this, humans and animals are radically different.

That difference is reason and free will. Humans have the ability to abstract more than what their senses perceive. Additionally, humans have the ability to choose, or more clearly, not to choose, what their appetites desire. Even if these two abilities are lost, absent or never developed, the dignity these faculties bring always remains. Humans, unlike animals, don't lose their dignity just because they've lost their functionality. Or to put it another way, I don't stop being human just because I can't think or choose.

It is this dignity that is why, although it was both permissible and laudable for my dad to shoot my dog suffering from a terminal illness, it is not permissible for him to do the same with my grandpa in the same state. Sure, we could choose a more antiseptic method of ending grandpa's life. The reality is, however, whether it is an excessive dose of morphine or a bullet to the head, the only moral difference is that one method requires less clean-up than the other.

Additionally, there is another level of dignity to human suffering that is not present in the suffering of animals. This dignity is seen most clearly in the example of Jesus Christ. Think of Jesus carrying His cross. Jesus chose both to suffer and to die. Of course, Jesus' death was not just any death, either. Jesus suffered one of the most painful deaths imaginable; death by crucifixion. Yet, He never gave up on it, even though His sufferings were infinitely more intense than any suffering any other human could imagine.

One of my favorite meditations while doing the Stations of the Cross is on the three falls of Jesus. The reality is that Jesus most likely fell more than three times. In fact, most of His journey to Calvary was probably more of a constant fall, or crawl, as He struggled so mightily to win our redemption.

Why does He get back up? The answer, of course, is profound. Jesus is not interested in taking the easy way out. No. Rather Jesus wants to prove just how much He loves by enduring all the suffering that is possible as a way of showing the strength of this love. The suffering of Jesus is not in vain. On the contrary, Jesus' suffering won for us our redemption. It was through the depth of His sacrifice that Jesus proved the strength of His love.

This is why, although we have no need to cling pointlessly to human life, there is a great value in allowing life to run its course. For rather than taking the quick and easy path of avoiding human suffering, which is precisely what euthanasia does, we follow Jesus up the narrow and difficult path that leads to salvation.






