#### Gift Cards for Children in Need

The Family Service Behavioral Health Program provides therapeutic services to youth and families in 23 Lincoln Public Schools and 8 surrounding county schools. Many of the families we are working with have been greatly impacted by COVID. Students are struggling with high levels of anxiety and/or depression both at school and home. Unfortunately, we are experiencing many students with suicidal ideation. We are trying hard to provide some stability and support during this time of uncertainty. We are actively working with students to teach them coping skills and ways to de-stress. We are also working with families to provide them with support and resources to better the family life. This has ranged from finding employment, daycare, and affordable housing. As the holidays near, the level of stress increases for students not knowing what these celebrations will be like. Many students may go without any gifts or few gifts due to lack of family financial hardship and cultural practices. There are often many toy drives, but this excludes older students at the middle and high school levels. Donations of gift cards to local stores and fast food restaurants are appreciated by these students!

We thank you for your generosity! In years past, the students are very grateful and even shed tears for the gift of a gift card. Some students expressed that they hadn't ever been to some of the stores or fast food places they received gift cards to. Any donation, big or small is appreciated. In an effort to try to celebrate Christmas Mass safely in the COVID era, and anticipating a number of visitors from outside the community, the following procedures will be in place for <u>Christmas masses only</u>:
