Legislative Alert

There are many bills before the legislature that are opposed to basic teachings of the Catholic Church. It is important for us to contact our state representative to encourage them to vote in a way that represents you. "Bad laws are only made by good citizens that remain silent". Here is a listing of the bills up for hearing and may be advanced for a vote. Let your voice be heard!

<u>LR20CA</u>: Eliminate Marriage Amendment. This proposes a ballot referendum for the voters to remove the state constitution's marriage amendment which defines marriage as exclusively between one man and one woman.

<u>LB20:</u> Mandates that all health insurance plans pay for hormonal contraceptives.

<u>LB183</u>: requires all hospitals-regardless of moral or religious views to dispense abortifacient emergency contraception to victims of sexual assault.

<u>LB97</u>: allows any two people to adopt a minor child. There are many other bills under consideration, go to www.necatholic.org and click on the legislative links to learn more.

LB120: Creates special protections for 'sexual orientation' and 'gender identity' for housing, public accomodations, and employment law.
