Friends,

Suppose for a moment that you held the sole winning ticket for a rather unusual lottery. In this lottery the winner could choose to receive \$1,000, \$5,000, \$10,000 or \$100,000 or \$1,000,000,000. Is there any doubt which you would choose? After all, more of a good thing is always better than less. It's the same thing with truth. The truth is the quintessential good thing because this truth is not so much an idea, a concept, or an opinion. The truth is a person, Jesus Christ, as He Himself says in the gospel of St. John.

Notice what this says about our world. If Jesus is identified with truth, then anywhere the truth is, Jesus is. Whether it is a truth of science or a truth of faith; wherever there is truth, there is Jesus, and wherever there is Jesus, there is the truth. You see, this is why everyone finds the truth attractive, even when the truth is difficult. When we discover the truth, we have discovered our Savior, whether we know it or not.

This is where our lottery analogy can provide us with some insight. As Catholics, we have won the truth lottery, because the Catholic Church possesses the fullness of truth since we are blessed to recognize Jesus' presence in the Blessed Sacrament.

The fact that we have won this lottery isn't a cause for self-righteousness or thinking ourselves lucky. Rather this should give us great pause for two reasons. First, like winning the lottery, we did absolutely nothing to earn our faith. It was not luck, but it was not earned either. Rather it is a free gift God gave us. Second, remember Jesus' words in the gospel, "To those who have been given more, more is expected" As Catholics, we are held to a higher standard since we have been blessed with more.

Recognize, also, that other Christian faiths have won the lottery. But since the fullness of truth is not there, it would be as if those belonging to them chose the \$10,000. Notice, no one would say winning \$10,000 in the lottery is a bad thing. Thus, no one should think that belonging to another religion is a bad thing. Similarly, everyone from atheists to Buddhists believes science is true. Thus, everyone has won the truth lottery, even if it is a relatively smaller amount.

Now, suppose someone winning \$5,000 in the lottery wished to exchange it for \$10,000. That would be a cause for great joy. So, too, it would be a cause for great joy if someone not blessed with any faith chose to devote themselves to Christ in some non-Catholic Christian denomination. Sure, it would not be as good for them as becoming Catholic. But it would be good for them nonetheless.

The converse, however, is equally true. Imagine what we'd think of someone who'd sell a billion dollars for \$10,000. That would be insane. For no one trying to accumulate wealth is very successful when they exchange more wealth for less.

It works the same way with truth. Why would we want to give up more truth for less? The only answer, of course, is because we were tricked into thinking that \$10,000 looks more attractive than \$1,000,000,000. Just as this can happen with frequency in the business world, so, too, it can happen with our faith. This is why we must constantly be safeguarding our faith from well-meaning, but misinformed, temptations. All religions are not created equal. While all are good, some are better than others.

This is often the source of consternation. The myth that all religions are the same is both easily believed and just as easily debunked. In fact, every time someone tells me that all religions are the same, I always respond by asking them to become Catholic. After all, if it doesn't matter what religion you profess, why not profess mine? No one has taken me up on this offer yet, and the reason is simple. Not all religions are the same and everyone knows it. In fact, everyone belongs instinctively to the religion they think is the best. Why else would they stay?

However, since religions make contrary claims that cannot be reconciled, they cannot be all equally good. Some contain more truth than others. We are so blessed to know the fullness of truth in the Catholic Church, and we should never be ashamed of that, but rather, eager to share it.


