<u>LB231</u>: Prohibits children from seeking certain forms of therapy (e.g., talk therapy, faith-based counseling, spiritual direction) when grappling with same-sex attraction and gender identity issues.

<u>LB229</u>: Seeks to define 'gender identity into state statute for the first time by amending state law governing hate crimes.

<u>LB357</u>: undermines the rights of parents, inserts problematic sexual orientation and gender identity nondiscrimination language and expands access to abortion for minors.

<u>LB517</u>: Adds a third gender-gender neutral on state operator's licenses and identification cards. <u>LB276</u>: eliminates physician presence during an abortion

# **Legislative Alert**

There are many bills before the legislature that are opposed to basic teachings of the Catholic Church. It is important for us to contact our state representative. "Bad laws are only made by good citizens that remain silent". Here is a listing of the bills up for hearing and may be advanced for a vote. Let your voice be heard! The Nebraska Catholic Conference is **opposed** to the following bills.

LR20CA: Eliminate Marriage Amendment. This proposes a ballot referendum for the voters to remove the state constitution's marriage amendment which defines marriage as exclusively between one man and one woman.

<u>LB67</u>: Allows contraceptive services to available in schools.

LB230: Creates special protections for 'sexual orientation' and 'gender identity' which would discriminate against those who have traditional moral or religious views about marriage and human sexuality.

The Nebraska Catholic Conference <u>supports</u> the following bills

<u>LB167</u>: Prohibits government from infringing on the religious liberty of church and other religious organizations during a state of emergency.

<u>LB597</u>: Provides \$2000 tax credit for parents who experience the still birth of an unborn child who has reached at least 20 weeks gestational age.

<u>LB364</u>: provides more scholarship opportunities for low-income and working-class children to attend a private school of their choice.

<u>LB396</u>: provides avenue for schools to purchase locally produced or processed foods for school meals.
