Friends,

There is a saying originating in the Middle Ages that I find extraordinarily profound. It is this: God always forgives. Man sometimes forgives. Nature never forgives. I suppose the meaning seems obvious. God, as one who is infinitely merciful, is never going to deny forgiveness to anyone who asks, regardless of the gravity of a particular offense. Human beings, to the extent they imitate God's love, patiently endure wrongs. However, to the extent that we do not imitate God, we often hold grudges, demand retribution and even exact our revenge on our perpetrator. Nature, on the other hand, never forgives. If I accidentally fall into a campfire, nature isn't going to say, "Well, that clumsy Fr. Olsen, I'm going to cut him some slack since he has enough problems". Nature is going to burn me every single time, whether I deserve it or not. Nature knows nothing of mercy and forgiveness. Nature is simply about cause and effect.

But it is always amazing to me how often these three simple statements are confused. For example, sometimes God's roll is confused with nature's like when someone posits that COVID is a punishment from God for society's decay. Although this does acknowledge God's intimate role in His creation, this type of thinking is immature. In fact, it is a remnant of an incomplete, Old Testament mindset.

In fact, this can be seen by looking more closely at the book of Deuteronomy. For in that book, Moses explains to the people that commandments the Lord has given them are both a blessing and a curse. They are blessing because obeying them will lead to happiness. But, they are a curse, because disobeying them leads to punishment.

It is here where the confusion lies. Moses, given his limited understanding, thinks that this is a punishment from God. On the surface, this makes some sense. Since God is the giver of the commandments, it seems logical that He is also the one in charge of their enforcement. In fact, this is why the Old Testament understanding of God seems so judgmental and even, at times, vindictive. God is seen only as the just Father, the one who returns to everyone exactly what he or she deserves.

But, with the coming of God the Son into our world, this limited understanding of God outlined in the Old Testament is supplemented. With the revelations of God the Son, we realize that God doesn't give each of us what we deserve. Rather God shows His infinite mercy by allowing us, time and time again, the opportunity to turn back and taste His generous mercy.

In reality, it is this same immature, Old Testament mindset that effects those claiming God is punishing some person or group for some transgression. Since God always forgives, whenever there are negative consequences for actions, they must result from either man or nature.

Of course, God always strives to make use of the catastrophes of our lives, be they great or small, in order to reach out to us. But, although He does permit such sufferings to enter our lives, He never, ever desires them. The only thing that God desires is to love. As St. John reminds us, God is Love. Perhaps, then, the next time we hear someone try to blame God for some misfortune in the world, recognize two things. First, what a blessing it is that the person doing this recognizes how intimately present God truly is in the world. And, second, say a prayer that all might recognize the wisdom laid out for humanity centuries ago; that God always forgives, man sometimes forgives and nature never forgives.

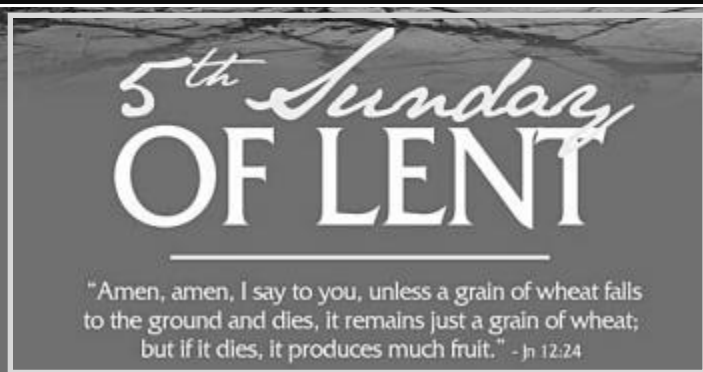
