Friends,

There is, perhaps, no more perfect example of fear than a little child lost from their parents. The feelings of abandonment and despair accompanying this experience are so profound that the lost child cannot usually explain their predicament to a helping adult because they are so consumed by tears. Yet, it is through the eyes of a lost child that we can begin to see the most horrific, and most forgotten, pains of the crucifixion.

In fact, the pain experienced by Jesus is similar to the pain suffered by the lost child. Recall what Jesus cries out while hanging on the cross cry. They are the very same words a lost child might be tempted to cry out while waiting for his parents at the supermarket counter. "Eloi, Eloi, lama sabacthani," provided the child spoke Aramaic. Or, in English, "My God, My God, why have You abandoned me." Jesus, having first been rejected by the Jews, and then abandoned by all of His so-called friends, now appears to feel abandoned by the one person that He put the most faith in; His Heavenly Father. Like a hand pressed up too close to an eye, God the Father is now so close to His Son, that Jesus, in His humanity, is no longer able even to see the Father. This perception is both devastating and terrifying.

Even during such horrific suffering, Jesus does not despair. Although the words "My God, My God why have you abandoned me," might sound desperate when taken in isolation, they are not. In fact, what Jesus is doing is intoning today's responsorial psalm, Psalm 22. Just like a patriot may intone the pledge of allegiance by simply saying, "I pledge allegiance..." or the prayer leader might begin by simply saying "Hail Mary" confident that others will join in, so, too, Jesus isn't simply saying this phrase and being done with it. He's inviting all His listeners, His congregation, to pray it with Him.

Psalm 22 is not a proclamation of despair. On the contrary, Psalm 22 is an affirmation of faith amidst suffering. Simply recall the last stanza. "I will proclaim Your name to my brethren; in the midst of the assembly I will praise You: You who fear the LORD, praise Him...give glory to Him all you descendants of Israel." Thus, by intoning Psalm 22, Jesus is not demonstrating that His sufferings have led to despair. Rather, Jesus is demonstrating the true depth of His faith by believing even though nothing is seen.

It seems to me that this thought can provide us with tremendous comfort during our own sufferings, be they physical or spiritual. In our sufferings, no matter how small or large they truly are, we find opportunity; the opportunity to test our dependence on God, the opportunity to become like little children. For it is precisely through this opportunity to suffer that we can accept the kingdom of God in our lives in the very same way Jesus accepted the kingdom of God through His suffering.

This identification with Jesus gives all of us who suffer several tremendous spiritual advantages. First, we are given the opportunity to help Jesus, not only make up for our own sins, but for the sins of others as well. Additionally, our special identification with the suffering of Jesus Christ makes us powerful intercessors on the behalf of everyone who asks us to pray for them. Also, our sufferings help us exercise virtues like patience and perseverance that may not get such a tiring workout without the weight of our sufferings. Finally, through our sufferings, we are given the opportunity to show the depth of our love by our ability to sacrifice; the hardest of which might be forcing us to become like a little child by forcing us to be dependent on God and others.

Thus, in kind of a weird way, the sufferings that we are forced to endure in this life can be viewed as blessings. Even though God doesn't desire human suffering, He permits it as a way of allowing us to participate in His redemptive mission. Of course, Jesus doesn't need our help in this process. He does invite it, however, so that we may grow closer to Him through that shared experience.




