Friends,

We are all familiar with the phrase, "actions have consequences". Less familiar, although equally true, is the phrase "inaction has consequences". In fact, the Irish political philosopher Edmund Burke summarizes this idea nicely when he says, "All that is necessary for evil to triumph is that good men do nothing."

This makes perfect sense. Imagine that you discover termites in your house. Since it would be a lot of work and cost, it seems only natural that one would desire simply to ignore the problem. What would that inaction do? The infestation would only magnify, making the problem worse and worse.

It seems to me that something analogous has happened in the Church. For in 1968, Pope Paul VI issued a letter called Humane Vitae, in Latin, or in English, On Human Life. In this letter, the pope reaffirmed the two-thousand-year-old prohibition of the use of contraception. Unfortunately, at the time the pope 'uncovered these termites', they had already infested many hearts. Even worse, many in the Church were intimidated by the work that would be needed to eradicate these termites from the human heart and chose to do nothing.

Of course, that only made the problem worse. Because of this inaction, the infestation of contraception has grown so powerful it now threatens to destroy five centuries of work in the United States. By leaving this infestation of contraception alone for almost fifty years, it has now become so pervasive that it threatens to destroy the institutions the Church worked so hard to develop in the five centuries following Columbus' discovery of the new world.

The first step in this process is understanding the insidious evil the use of contraception disguises so well. You see, contraceptives are a direct attack on the first and most foundational building block of a healthy society – good and stable marriage. Contraceptives do this by introducing violence and deception into the marital act. To better understand this attack, first notice that whenever marriage is discussed in the bible, it almost always does so using the imagery of two becoming one flesh.

When does this one flesh union happen in marriage? It happens that night in the marital act where the two individuals unite physically in a sacred moment we call the marital act. In fact, each and every time a married couple unites physically in the marital act, they are really reaffirming their wedding vows by stating with their bodies that these two are one flesh (and we all know that our actions speak louder than our words)!

Notice what the introduction of contraception does to this one-flesh union. Barrier methods (e.g. condoms, sponges, diaphragms, etc...) prevent unity from developing as their very name implies. If you are trying to unite with someone, do you need a "barrier"? If you are giving yourself totally to someone, do you need "protection"?

Of course, hormonal methods (e.g. birth control pills, shots, IUDS, etc...) don't share this same difficulty. Since there is no physical barrier put in place, one might assume that unity between spouses could take place. This is false. Since fertility is excluded from the act, the couples are not giving themselves totally to each other. In fact, the married couples using hormonal methods of contraceptives are deceiving each other in a most sinister and profound way. They are lying with their bodies. With their bodies, married couples are communicating that they are totally giving themselves to each other. But they are intentionally withholding their fertility.

This is part of the reason why the Church teaches today, as it has always taught throughout history, that the use of contraception is a grave sin. When combined with free consent and full knowledge (which, by the way, you now have if you've read this article), this makes the use of contraception a mortal sin that must be confessed prior to receiving the Most Holy Eucharist. In fact, it seems to me, that this is the true reason why traditional marriage is under attack and why the dignity of the human person is under attack. So many otherwise good and holy men and women are doing nothing with this evil of contraception. That is all it takes for evil to prevail.


