Friends.

It is really quite amazing how quiet large groups of people can sometimes be. Simply think about how hundreds fall silent as they strain to hear every delicate note of a live Broadway performance, or how thousands of basketball fans can be quieter than in a church as their hometown hero approaches the free throw line during the closing seconds of a tight game. Heck, even the 90,000 Husker fans infesting Memorial Stadium on a football Saturday fall silent when the opposing team scores a go-ahead touchdown with very little time remaining.

Of course, the greatest moment of silence the entire realm of creation has ever experienced is when a humble young virgin, probably not yet sixteen years old, was busy attending to her daily duties. Suddenly, this humble virgin is confronted by a magnificent and fearful sight. An angel of the Lord, Gabriel by name, appears before her very eyes. Quite understandably, the appearance of one of God's holy angels terrifies this humble virgin.

But, even more frightening than the appearance of an angel is the greeting that Gabriel brings. "Hail, full of grace! The Lord is with you." These words must have struck Mary like of fist. For although Mary is quite certain of the Lord's love for her, being called "full of grace" by one of God's angels is an entirely different story. Imagine how you'd recoil if an angel appeared to you and told you that you were full of grace. Wouldn't we be overwhelmed precisely because we know how unworthy we really are?

Mary would be no different. In fact, Mary's horror at this greeting would be far more profound than either yours or mine would be, even though it is true for her and not us. After all, our humility is not as profound as hers. As a result, this increased humility allowed Mary to understand better than we do her littleness before God. This is why this greeting terrified her. She seemed too insignificant to be called "full of grace".

Yet what is Mary's response? "How can this be, since I have no relations with a man." This puzzling response is really quite rational. You see, Mary has already promised God that she will forgo marital relations with any man for the sake of the kingdom of heaven. Thus, Mary asks Gabriel how she can possibly consent to his request to be a mother and yet not renege on the vow of virginity she has already sworn. Gabriel quite willingly resolves Mary's dilemma. "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you," Gabriel responds.

Then it happens; the moment where silence falls not simply in the symphony hall, the basketball court or even Memorial Stadium. NO! This was the moment the whole of creation falls silent. The fate of the entire realm of creation rests upon Mary's answer. If Mary says no, the disobedience of Eve becomes complete, and all of creation wallows in the sorrow of knowing God and His creation are now enemies permanently. But, if Mary says yes and consents to undo the disobedience of Eve, all of creation is restored to a right relationship with God through her Son, Jesus Christ. Thus, the importance of Mary's response necessitates that all of creation falls silent, anxiously awaiting her reply.

Finally, though, this longest, most agonizing second in history ends. "Behold," Mary says, "I am the handmaid of the LORD. May it be done to me according to your word." Now the world rejoices because Mary has consented to become the new Eve. For just as sin and death entered the world through Eve's disobedience, so now forgiveness and life enter the world through Mary's obedience.

Perhaps now we begin to see more clearly just how important Mary's role is in bringing about our salvation. For although not absolutely necessary for salvation since God needs no help in doing anything, Mary was chosen by God as an indispensable cog in the machinery of redemption. This is why Mary holds a special place not just in the Church. For it was the will of God to make our salvation dependent on Mary's affirmation so that, just as Jesus could undo the sin of Adam, Mary could undo the disobedience of Eve.


