Friends,

I'm fairly certain that most of us probably aren't too familiar with the 17th century French Philosopher Rene Descartes. For even if we recognize him as the inventor of analytic geometry and the source of the famous phrase, "I think, therefore, I am", it is unlikely that we appreciate his impact on the modern world.

While this understanding of the human being may seem irrelevant, even if it is true, it really isn't. On the contrary, the consequences of this philosophy is the misunderstanding that our bodies are merely machines that are used to house our souls. They are not really who we truly are. This, in turn, makes our bodies both changeable and even disposable. Since our bodies are not part of who we truly are, what we do with them or in them has little or no impact on our humanity.

This divorce between our bodies and our souls is now deeply rooted in our society. In fact, every year I do a little exercise with my students to demonstrate this. I ask one student to come forward, and I say, "everyone, look at John". This they do with almost no reaction. Then, I invite them to look at John's body. You can probably guess what happens next. Not only does John become extremely self-conscious, but also the entire class almost can't help but giggle. Our society has so disconnected our bodies from our souls that we no longer recognize that they are essential to who we are.

The transgender movement is the fruit of this line of thinking. If human beings are really just a ghost trapped in the machine of their body, then who I am is simply who I think myself to be. It is independent of any physical limitation my body may place on me. If I think myself male then, my body either confirms that reality or I mutilate it until it does (which can never actually be done, btw). If I think myself female, then my body either conforms to that reality or I mutilate it until it does. If our bodies are just tools for our soul, then who we really are is not determined by any physical limitation, including our body. We can modify them as we see fit.

Notice how different this understanding is than the understanding of Catholic Christianity. Catholics believe that our bodies and souls are essentially "married" to each other by God. And, what God has joined together, no human being must separate. And, remember what St. Paul says about our bodies. "Do you not know," St. Paul says, "that your bodies are members of Christ?" After all, when Jesus died for us, He didn't just purchase our souls. He purchased our bodies as well. This is why St. Paul notes, not only that "You have been purchased at a great price", but also immediately adds the exhortation, "So glorify God in your body."

Our bodies, according to St. Paul, are "temples of the Holy Spirit." This is why sins against our bodies are especially shameful. "Every other sin a person commits is outside the body," St. Paul continues "but the immoral person sins against his own body." St. Paul understands that our bodies are as much of who we are as our souls are. In fact, this is why sins against our body, what St. Paul calls "immorality", always elicits more shame. When we are "immoral", we hurt, not just our soul, but our bodies as well. Is it any wonder why the suicide rates for those choosing transgenderism is eighteen times higher than it is for society as a whole? To deny the truth of our body leads to a horribly conflicted life.

Our denials do not have to be so profound to be dangerous. Every time we fall victim to the lie that "it's my body and I can do what I want with it", whether this is seen in fornication, adultery, unchastity within marriage (especially the use of artificial contraception), homosexuality, abortion, tattoos and exotic piercings, pornography, prostitution, exhibitionism, and the list goes on and on, we push society away from the path of Jesus Christ. If we want to do something about issues like men competing in girls' sports, we don't need to condemn, judge, mock or stigmatize. We need to love. The best way to begin that process is by learning to respect our own bodies as temples, temples of the Holy Spirit.


