Friends,

I sometimes lament that I was born in 1969 and not, say, 1999. For instance, when I graduated from college in 1991, I had to go out and look for a job. As surprising as it may sound, there were several reputable companies that refused to hire me. Shocking, I know!! Perhaps even more shocking, however, was that they claimed to have someone more qualified. Had I been born thirty years later, perhaps I would have had some legal recourse to this clear injustice; an injustice I like to call 'quality discrimination'. After all, how dare someone not hire me simply because they think someone else might do a better job? Is it my fault I was born with less intelligence, less talent and less ability? Of course not! Employers should not be permitted to discriminate against people like me who can't do a job as well as someone else can!

Although this (hopefully) sounds ridiculous, our country is heading down this ridiculous path. Whether it's gender identity issues or permitting persons with same-sex inclinations to marry each other, discrimination is common accusation leveled against those opposed. Of course, it may seem that protection from discrimination is moral imperative that all Catholic Christians should fight for whenever the opportunity arises. But, is it?

Let's think about discrimination more deeply. Sometimes discrimination is not only permitted, but also even laudable. For instance, we discriminate against criminals by locking them up and taking away their rights because of the choices they have made. We discriminate against children by not allowing them to drive, vote or drink until they have reached a certain age because of the choices that they might make. We even discriminate against men and women by forcing them to use separate bathrooms when they relieve themselves because of things beyond their control. Clearly, discrimination is not always bad. In fact, sometimes it is prudent and necessary.

Notice, however, that when it comes to marriage, there is no discrimination occurring in any way. In fact, those with same-sex inclinations have the same rights to get married as those with heterosexual inclinations do. Just as those attracted to members of the opposite sex have the right to marry a person of the opposite gender, so, too, persons attracted to members of the same-sex possess the exact same right. They, too, can marry persons of the opposite gender. There is no discrimination.

But, before we go too much further down this road, we must first recognize a crucial distinction. Notice that the Church never refers to 'homosexuals', 'gays' or 'lesbians'. Rather the Church is always using the term same-sex inclination or attraction. After all, a person should not be reduced to any property or quality they may possess, including their sexual preference. All of us are human beings, created in the image and likeness of God. To reduce anyone to merely one aspect of humanity is to denigrate the dignity of that person.

Since those with same-sex attractions are indeed just as much in the image of God as you or me, shouldn't they have the same protection you and I do from discrimination regarding employment, housing and public accommodation? Shouldn't they be afforded all of the legal benefits that those married couples possess? Isn't in discrimination to deny them just because they happen to be attracted to members of the same gender?

Well, first of all, we have to notice that there is a subtle, yet critical, difference between this type of 'discrimination' and discriminating based on gender or ethnicity. For while gender and ethnicity are clearly not choices, there is still at least some debate with regard to same-sex attractions.

But, for argument's sake, let's suppose that it is an absolutely certain fact that people no more choose their sexual orientation than people choose their gender or their race. Any 'discrimination' would still be based on choices rather than on something uncontrolled. After all, how would anyone know what a person's sexual orientation is unless it had been divulged by some action along the way? And, if it were, wouldn't it be permissible to discriminate in certain circumstances as we do with other actions? In fact, think about what would happen if it had been divulged that I am sexually attracted to my landlord or my landlord's wife. Is that going to effect my application? 

(*continued from page 1) Is revealing my sexual attraction toward my interviewer going to get me hired? If revealing my sexual preferences is going to hurt business, should an employer be forced to ignore it?

Of course, as we have noted, in the case of marriage, the person with same sex inclination experiences no discrimination at all. They possess the exact same rights to marry that you do and that I do. They may choose not to exercise those rights, as I have done, but should they benefit from this choice just because they are oriented toward people of the same gender?

The answer is clearly no. After all, suppose I were sexually oriented to a can of Dr. Pepper. Do I then have the legal right to "marry" that can of Dr. Pepper? Should I get tax benefits from this "marriage"? Will my can of Dr. Pepper receive my pension benefits when I die? Can I get it covered by my health insurance? And, if you're snickering at this, you're a 'pepperaphobe'! How dare you belittle me because of my sexuality!!

But, Father, it may be argued, that's just silly. A can of Dr. Pepper is an inanimate object. No one thinks marriage should be between a person and an inanimate object?

Well, I might respond, not yet they don't. Give it twenty years and talk to me. After all, when I was in high school the idea of so-called "gay marriage" was as laughable as so-called "Dr. Pepper marriage. Now that "homosexual marriage" has become the law of the land, the only thing preventing "Dr. Pepper marriage" or "bestiality marriage" or "child marriage" or any other "marriage" is public opinion. And, we all know how fickle and malleable public opinion can be.

This is why, in terms of civil rights and protections, there is a clear difference between those with same-sex attractions and those that are Black, Hispanic, Asian or women. Same-sex attractions are not self-evident in the same way race and gender are. In fact, they are only revealed through actions. And, actions have consequences, even to the point of causing us to be treated in a different manner.

- 1.) Eligible candidates must register. Catholics in good standing with the Church and are at least a rising junior in high school are eligible. Registration is now live via internet. Contact your parish office to obtain the link to register.
- 2.) In late July the Archdiocese will send a reminder to those who have registered for this liturgical formation session.
- 3.) In August the candidates will view the formation video.
- 4.) Following the session, candidates will complete an online follow-up form.
- 5.) Following your local tutorial, pastors (and designated chaplains in the case of high schools) will schedule Mandation as soon as is convenient.
