Friends,

Our journey to heaven kind of reminds me of a tightrope walker suspended hundreds of feet in the air with nothing but an inch wide rope to support him. If he strays but a little, it will lead to a catastrophic fall. Of course, there is a difference between our journey to heaven and a tightrope walker. The tightrope walker has help; specifically, a long pole to aid his balance. We, on the other hand, have the devil that, as soon as we begin teetering even slightly in any wrong direction, quickly pounces to push us to

Perhaps nowhere is this reality clearer than with the virtue of patience. After all, there are probably millions of ways to error with our patience, but only one way to succeed. Shoot, I might even wager that if there is one virtue most of us would readily admit we lack, it is the virtue of patience. In fact, one of my favorite prayers is to beg the Lord for patience and demand that He do it quickly!

I wonder, though, is the Lord slow or is He patient? For example, the first year I was fishing in Canada, I decided to pull ashore to eat lunch. Now the area I stay at is very undeveloped. Nevertheless, as I boated around, I suddenly discovered a sand beach with a rock shaped like an easy chair. It even had a flat spot on the right "arm" where I could set my Dr. Pepper. Of all the luck!

But, of course, we as Catholics know that there is no such thing as luck. Luck didn't guide my steps to find that beach. Luck didn't form that rock and place it there for me to use. No! It was not luck, but providence. God designed the whole world so that on that day at that time that rock would be at that spot.

Think for a moment of the patience God shows in doing such things. It took, literally, thousands of years to form that rock and tailor it to such perfect specifications for my needs. After all, that rock, like so much of this world, was most likely formed by the last ice age. Perhaps we can all identify with how slow a glacier moves. Certainly, an extreme example of patience on God's part to form it so perfectly!

Notice what the fruit of God's patience is. Through it, God shows His love most uniquely. You see, God's love is not some esoteric, pie-in-the-sky feeling. It has tangible, real dimensions that manifest themselves every day. My experience is hardly unique. In fact, it happens to all of us, perhaps even thousands of times a day. For the reality is that everything we see was placed there for us by God to be noticed as a sign of His love for us. Much like the loving parent playing peek-a-boo with their infant, God, our loving Father, does the same thing, thousands of times, every day of our life.

Unfortunately, we so often miss it! Why? One of the reasons is that we are too busy rushing around from one duty to another. We all live very busy lives; lives that are full of stress and anxiety. All of this busyness, however, results in one of the worst, if not the worst, consequence of lack of patience. Even though we may think our lack of patience is seen most profoundly in our unloading on our families, coworkers, distracted drivers or whomever, it is not. These outbursts pale in comparison to the worst consequence of our impatience – the consequence of missing God and His love for us!

This consequence is so devastating precisely because it exacerbates everything. When we don't see God in our world, we make the world a living hell. In fact, the very definition of hell is the absence of God! However, the converse is also true. Since heaven is seeing God face to face, the more we see Him here on earth, the happier we become. We experience the foretaste of the joys of heaven each and every time we see God in our world.

Perhaps this gives us a new insight into developing our patience. How? Well, first and most importantly, be patient! (How's that for piercing insight!) It takes time to develop patience, sometimes longer than we would like or think it should.

Second, begin with the Mass. Mass is the perfect time to practice patience. In Mass, we can step off the hamster wheel of our busy lives and enjoy the most potent presence of God in our world. If we can grow in our patience at Mass, the fruits will, literally, be out of this world. For the better we can see God in the ultimate peek-a-boo moment of the Eucharist, the better we will see as He works in every other aspect of our lives as well. Believe me, this is worth the wait. All it takes is a little bit of patience


