Friends,

I always marvel at the story of the healing of the ten lepers as found in the Gospel of St. Luke. I mean, think for a minute how bad it would stink to suffer from leprosy. Not only is leprosy horribly painful because the disease literally eats away at the person's skin, but also, since the disease is highly contagious, Jewish law mandates that a leper be treated like second class citizen. Thus, the leper must always identify himself to others from afar by shouting, "Unclean! Unclean!" He must always wear ragged clothes and leave his hair unkempt. He is only permitted to speak with non-lepers in the most urgent of situations, and even then, he must do so only in a muffled or indirect way. And perhaps worst of all, the leper is to be ostracized from the community, which means his only companionship can come, not from family and friends, but from others that share that disease.

What a blessing it would be, then, to be freed from such a horrible condition, let alone freed miraculously. And yet, upon discovering this reality, only one of the lepers returns to thank Jesus for His miracle. What incredible ingratitude!

But, before we get to carried away in our own self-righteousness, we must ask ourselves if we would behave any differently. After all, it is easy to picture the nine ungrateful lepers, so overjoyed about seeing their family and friends again that they think it's best to get a clean bill of health from the priests so that they can return to share this joy with their families. And having accomplished this, they might then intend to return to Jesus and give thanks, if they can find Him and if they remember. Notice, by not putting gratitude first, the nine ungrateful lepers, just like the rest of us, lose its incredible benefits.

And not only that, but also think of the "miracles" we have taken for granted in our own lives – miracles like our life, our health, being born in the greatest country in the world, having food on the table and clothes on our back, having a place of shelter and a place of worship, or most importantly of all, the gift of our faith. The miracle of our existence is a personal favorite. Think of it this way. Every couple I've ever married has some quirky story about how they fell in love. Well, so do their parents, grandparents, great-grandparents, etc... to the point that if someone in Medieval Europe stops to pick eight flowers instead of seven, none of the correct chain of events ever happen so that we are conceived. Now that's a miracle! You see, there is a reason so many people think that they are the center of the universe. The reason is because they are!!! The difficulty is that too many think they're the only ones who are the center, the apple of God's eye if you will. But the reality is that God has designed and guided the whole world so intimately and so profoundly with the specific purpose of bringing each of us into existence.

And how many times have we said thank you? And notice who my ingratitude effects. It doesn't affect God. You see, God is not some passive-aggressive teenager who pouts because He's not thanked for the gifts He has given. Nor does He withhold His blessings out of spite for our incredible ingratitude. No. Our ingratitude doesn't affect God at all. Rather, our ingratitude affects us. How? (Continued on last page.)

(Continued from cover page.) To answer this question, simply think about two children on Christmas morning. Both receive the same gifts, but one expected everything he received and the other received more than he ever expected. Clearly the second child is going to be happier, but why? The answer is because he is more grateful. For not having been bound by expectations, the second child more easily recognizes that his presents are gifts, not entitlements. As a result, he is far more grateful, and it is gratitude that infallibly leads to happiness.

And yet how often do we make the mistake of the first child by thinking we are entitled to realities that are really gifts? And notice what this does to our gratitude. After all, it is impossible to be grateful for something we think we are owed. Additionally, when the gift that we think we are owed is taken away, or not given, or given less than what we would like, we become upset, sad and even angry. The only fruit our entitlement mentality has reaped is misery.

And this is why it is so important for us first to recognize our gifts, and then express our gratitude. For the more we recognize the immensity of our blessings, the less our gifts become entitlements and the more they are recognized for what they truly are – gifts. And this, in turn, will bring us joy. For not only will we better understand just how much we are loved by God, who blesses us much more than any of us could ever imagine, but also, like the child on Christmas morning that receives more than they expect, we will be filled with gratitude. And this gratitude infallibly brings us joy. For the happiest people in the world are not the ones with the most blessings. They are the ones with the most gratitude.




