#### Friends.

There is a story recounted by one of my favorite authors about three demons who are preparing to graduate from demon school. Their last hurdle before graduation is an oral exam conducted by the devil himself. And, perhaps not surprisingly, the only question the devil asks is this. "What is the best way to tempt mankind?" The first demon responded timidly, "by convincing them that there is no God." "You fool," the devil snarled, stabbing the demon with his pitchfork. "Have you never seen a sunset? One look at a sunset, or the countryside, or a newborn infant is all anyone really needs to prove that God exists. Report to the torturer immediately for wasting my time."

Satan then turned his snarl toward the second demon, and asked him the same question. "How would you tempt mankind?" This second demon cautiously replied, "I would try to convince mankind that there are no demons." "You fool," the devil growled, again stabbing the demon with his pitchfork. "Have you learned nothing. There is too much evil in the world for anyone to believe that demons don't exist. Ioin your comrade in dungeon."

Now, the third demon was the slyest of them all. Ignoring the fate of his comrades, he boldly sauntered up to Satan and, without being asked, boasted, "I will tempt mankind into thinking they have plenty of time to prepare." The devil glared at this third demon for a long time before he finally sneered. "Well done, my son. Be off about this work."

Of course, there is no question that this demon has been tremendously successful. For it probably seems like only yesterday that you received your first communion, or graduated high school, or got married, or had your first child, or watched your last child leave home, or celebrated your 25th anniversary, or mourned the loss of your parents. In fact, if your anything like me, each year seems to go by faster than the one before. And this does make some mathematical sense. After all, when you're ten, living another year means living 1/10th of your life. But when you're a hundred, that same year now appears ten times shorter. And even though some years were good and perhaps others were not, the truth is really the same for all. Time really does fly, whether you are having fun or not.

Now one of the ways the demons keep us from noticing how quickly time is flying by is to keep us distracted with our busy-ness. And boy has this been successful in our day. After all, how many of us have work that we need to do, schedules to be coordinated, errands to run, bills to pay, shopping to do, cards to send, relatives to visits, parties to plan, parties to attend, chores to do and so on and so on. In many ways, our lives resemble hamsters running on their wheels. We are running furiously, but not really going anywhere.

Naturally, the reason why we find ourselves spending so much time working on so many different things is that the devil will use anything, even very good things, in order to entice us to stay busy. For he knows that sooner rather than later we will have become so busy preparing for so many things that we will have forgotten to prepare for the one thing we are most certain of – that we will meet Jesus Christ after our death.

Fortunately for us as Catholics, however, we are extraordinarily blessed to have the Church for our mother. And this motherly Church gently nags us about these dangers and the need to prepare for Our Lord's judgement. And a prime example of this gentle nagging is the season of Advent, which begins today. For, during this Advent season, we are called to prepare for Our Lord's coming.

This coming of Our Lord, however, has two levels. On one level, it refers to the birth of Jesus on Christmas day. On another level, it refers to Our Lord's Second Coming at the end of the world. We must use the precious little time we have during this Advent season as a preparation for both levels. For, even if we do not live to see the Lord's Second Coming, we will certainly live to see Him when He judges us

How do we use this Advent season to avoid this and prepare for Our Lord's coming? There are several possibilities. Going to daily mass once in a while, going to confession, or even spending some quality time with Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, are all good examples. Even more importantly we must begin to incorporate Our Lord into the busy-ness of our everyday lives. This is not as difficult as we might think. For instance, one could say a little prayer, even one as simple as "Blessed be God," every time we get into a car, check our email, drink a cup of coffee, tie our shoe or even hear someone swear.

These are by no means small steps, especially given the catastrophic consequences of our lack of preparation. For our God is never outdone in generosity. Even when we begin to make these small steps, Jesus will bless us in ways we never imagined. More importantly, though, these little acts of preparation help ensure that, when Our Lord finally does come for us, be it at the end of the world or the end of our lives, we will not be caught unprepared. 




